

International Storytelling

Concurrently with national section of storytelling festival, the interntational section is held as well. In this section, all winners of previous Kanoon festivals, either from regional, national and international sections, all storytellers and professional presenters, and the interested storytellers from other countries can participate in this section.

Participants

- ✓ Winners of all levels: regional, national and international of previous festivals (except those storytellers at the level of national and international (final stage) not selected more than three times.
- ✓ Professional storytellers and performers;
- ✓ Interested storytellers from other countries;

Tales' Audience

✓ Toddlers, Children, Adolescents, Adults

Stages

- 1) Enrolling at the site and uploading the work, profile and documents;
- 2) Forming supervision and judging groups to evaluate the uploaded works;
- 3) Intrducing selected works to compete at the final stage;
- 4) Final competition at closing ceremony;

Conditions

- ✓ If the tale is performed in a different dialect or non-Farsi language, a copy of the tale in English must be delivered to the jury in written form;
- ✓ The time allocated to a tale ranges between 8 to 20 minutes;
- ✓ Storytellers at international section can choose only one tale. They cannot change their tale during the procedures of this section;
- Participants at the International Section cannot participate at national, custom-ceremony, and sing language sections;
